This year all students will be borrowing books each week during their library lesson, to read in their classroom during quiet reading time. However students can still borrow extra books to take home, providing they have a library bag to protect the book while in transit. Drawstring cloth bags are ideal, but thick plastic bags, cloth shopping bags and pillow cases are also acceptable.

Even though teachers aim to make every year a year of reading, we have no excuses in 2012!



Public libraries in partnership with the government, schools, publishers & many other interested groups have officially named 2012 the **National Year of Reading** to help Australians discover and rediscover the magic of reading.

As well as our existing literacy programs at Manning Gardens, to help our students develop a love of reading we are encouraging all students to participate in the 2012 Premiers Reading Challenge (PRC).

And the challenge is that students in K-2 must read (or have read to them) 30 books and Yrs 3-6 students must read 20 books by 1 September 2012!

The majority of the books read must be listed on the PRC booklists –go to <u>https://</u>

products.schools.nsw.edu.au/prc/home.html for more information. Students who meet the Challenge will receive a signed certificate from NSW Premier Barry O'Farrell (although sadly, not in person!).



Parents and carers, we are seeking your support in helping your children achieve their reading goals. Your support could be as little as asking your children how they are progressing with their challenge, or simply reminding them to return their library book so they may borrow another PRC book. Of course reading a book to them or helping them with their reading would be fantastic for many reasons. If you have access to the internet at home, you can even help your children record each book they have read, otherwise this will be done at school. If you have any questions about the PRC please see your child's teacher or Mrs Johnson in the Library.








The Solid State Circus came to Manning Gardens two weeks ago. The kids had great fun watching all their amazing stunts and acrobatics.
