We expect all students to be in school uniform every day of the week. Students wear our standard school uniform every Monday to Thursday. On Friday, our students wear sports uniform. You can purchase a sport polo shirt from our school office for \$15. This is great value as our polo shirts are 100% quality and have the school emblem on them. When your child wears their sports polo shirt on a Friday, they also get 5 house points. These points go towards the annual house points tally to find our winning sports house.

At Manning Gardens PS, we have a bike and scooter policy that has been in existence for many years now. The bike and scooter policy is all about keeping your child safe and protected as they ride to and from school. Only students 10 years or older can ride a bike or scooter to school. They must also have a bike/scooter permit and be wearing a helmet, in compliance with the law.

This term your child's class teacher will be writing a Semester 1 student report. This report will document your child's academic and social progress at school in Terms 1-2. Don't forget you can meet with your child's class teacher at any time to discuss issues and matters relating to your child.
