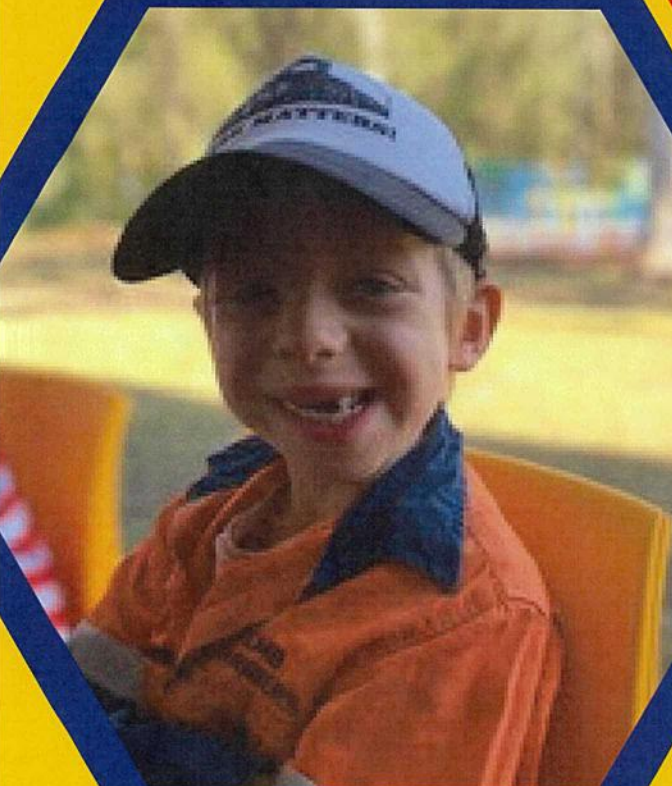
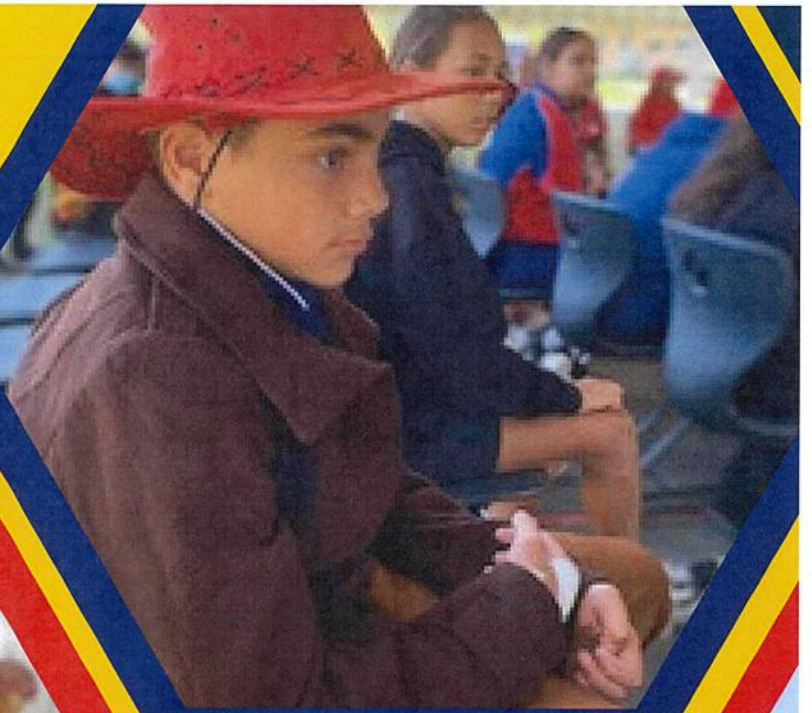
We have a Father's Day stall on Thursday for our students to pick up a gift for dad, pop or uncle.

It is a Department of Education requirement that parents and caregivers explain student absences.

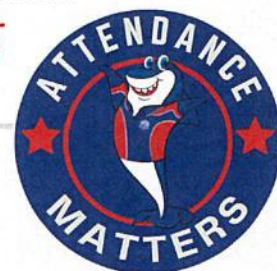
We have two mottos for attendance:

Make It Count

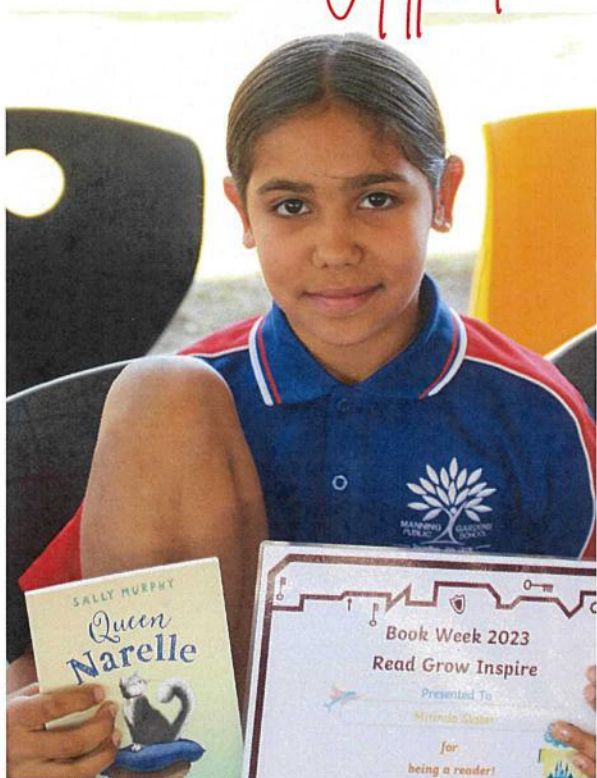

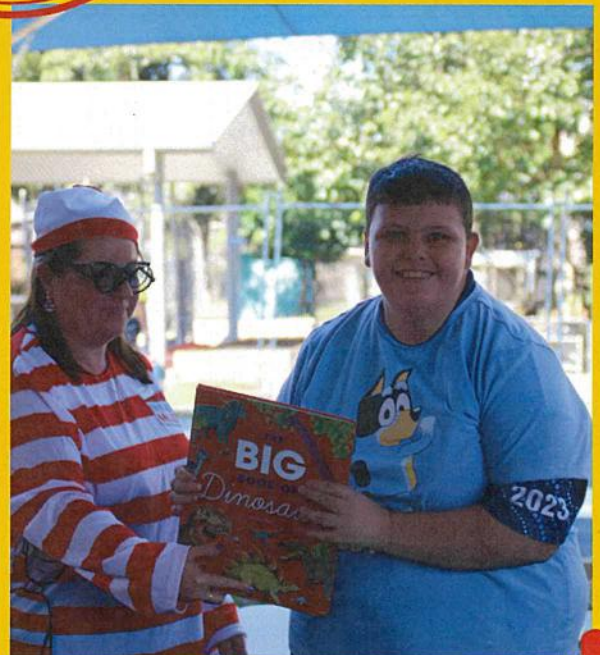
